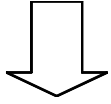

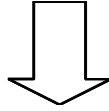
State Motto

COMMUNITY



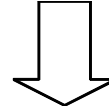
- result of identity and stability

IDENTITY

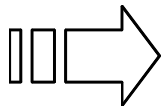


- result of genetic engineering

- state needs power of whole society to be strong
- great group doesn't accept mavericks

- Motto is incompatible with individual freedom

The main goal: **Stability** (after vast instability during the Nine Year's War)

The foundation of stability is happiness:

- Conditioning/people need to like what they are and do (p. 16)
- caste system → no one feels unsatisfied/unhappy (p.191/192)
- neither family nor true love → strong emotions = instability (p. 38)
- youth until they are sixty (p.95)
- no fear of death
- old things are prohibited → no distraction from the new things (p.188)
- no high art (Shakespeare) → tragedy= instability (p. 189/190)
- real science is abandoned → truth could easily replace the main goal of happiness (p. 195-196)
- God is locked in the safes → no use (people are not unhappy) + incompatible with scientific medicine (cloning etc.) (p. 201)
